## Hello everyone

We enter November with more of a reminder of the tragedies that lie within the world. The Middle East continues to be full of such turmoil. On the 7th October the world was shocked to hear the news of how Hamas had attacked Israel, raping women, killing young and old, including children and kidnapping in excess of 220, taking them into captivity. The actions of Hamas resulted in both Israelis and Palestinians suffering from the long-term effects of terrorism in their midst.

Something else happened in Gaza the other day that is worth noting for each of us. Four hostages were released and I hope by the time you read this there will be more. One of the hostages that was released, an 85 year old lady, was filmed making her way along the underground tunnels. As she was handed over by her captors she turns back to one of them, shakes his hand, and says "Shalom", which means peace! There is an important reminder for all of us. Whatever she experienced, her cry was for peace, even for her enemy. Our prayer today is also for peace as our hearts go out to both Palestinians and Israelis. Shalom!

Paul said, "And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4 verse 7) As we look to these distant lands, we must never forget that the hopes of peace must begin with us individually. May we begin by seeking to know peace with each other and peace as we share this community of Perry, sharing the love of God who cares for us all.
